- 7. What do you believe are the largest issues facing you, as you strive to comply with the Safe Drinking Water Act as a homeowner who needs to take care of your landscape/lawn?
- 8. If you have a home landscape to take care of, how do you plan to deal with the impacts the Safe Drinking Water Act has or will have on your landscaping care?
- 9. What do you think about public involvement in involvement in protecting drinking water quality?
- 10. Do you consider taking action to protect drinking water quality? Why or why not?
