WHAT IS UFCTI?

The UF Critical Thinking Inventory measures critical thinking style on a continuum that ranges between Engagement and Seeking information. Although the spectrum contains two ends, UFCTI participants can fall anywhere in between.

APPLYING UFCTI RESULTS

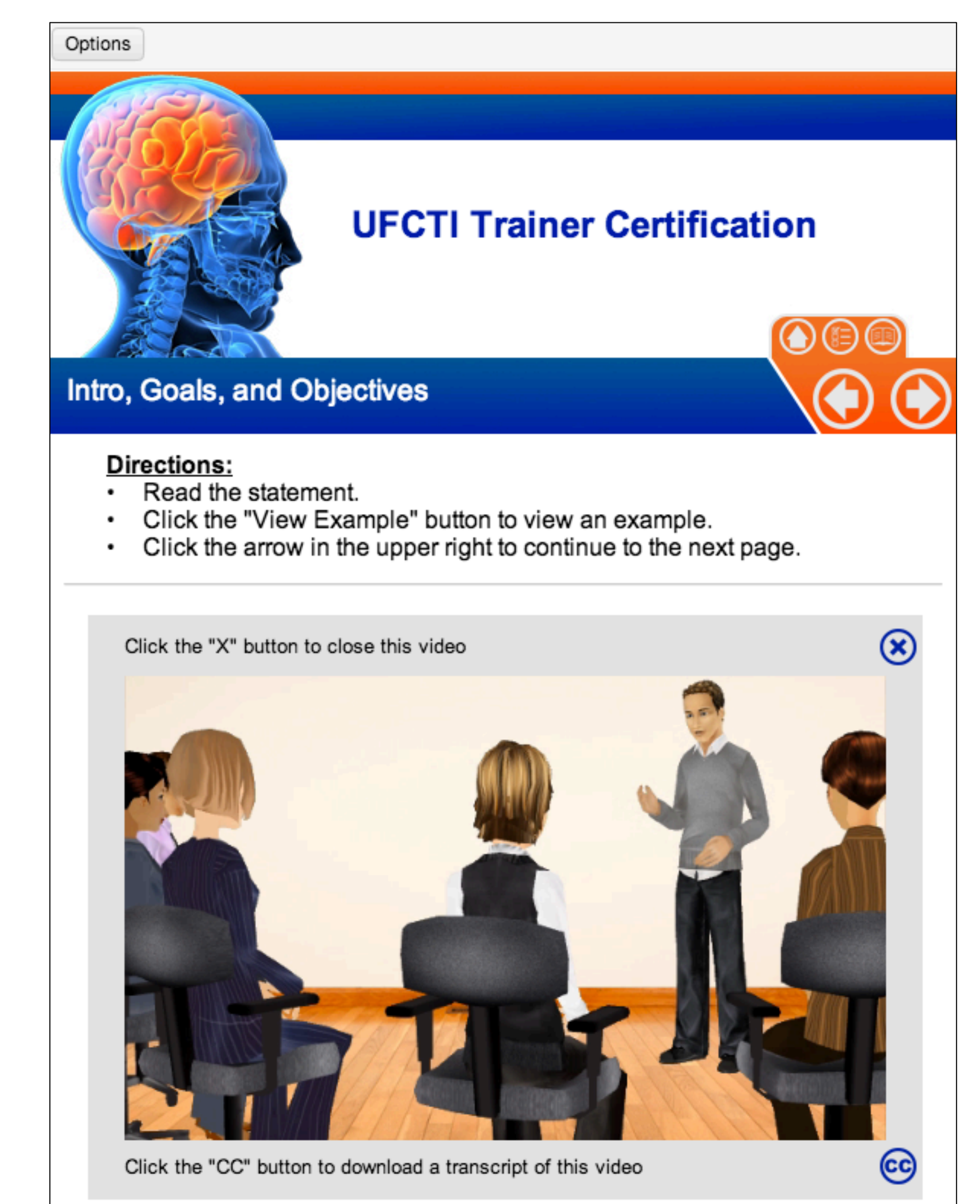
By understanding how different people think critically about an issue, you can put your students and/or team members in a position to succeed by grouping people together in the most effective way.
